Tasting Notes:

Soft yellow colour, full, strong, rich lasting.

Intense notes of white peach, citrus fruits, supported by a minerality which one can identify at the back of the mouth.

Great finesse and elegance, a finish of yellow fruits like Mirabelle and blood orange with occasional notes of crushed blackcurrants or menthol.

The appellation Communale du vignoble de l'Auxerrois, in the Yonne. It was formed by decree on 10th January 2003 and replaced the old appellation of Sauvignon de Saint-Bris. Production takes place in Saint-Bris-Le-Vineux, Chitry, Irancy, Quenne and Vincellotes.

It is an exceptional burgundy because it is the only appellation which is allowed to use the sauvignon grape.

Soil argilo-calcaire Kimmeridgien et portlandien.

Production 12000 bottles.

Bersan et Fils have 36 hectares and the family have lived in Saint-Bris-le-Vineux for 5 centuries.
